General rules for all competitions

1. The competitions are open to students of MBBS of all years.
2. Registration for the guest lectures is mandatory in order to participate in any of the events.
3. Students can participate in any number of competitions. This must be clearly indicated in the online registration form itself along with the topic selected.

Note: Topics for the painting and creative working model competitions are hyper linked in the registration form. Selection of topic must be done during registration itself. No change in the topic selected shall be allowed after online registration is completed by the participant.

4. All the participants should report to the respective Co-ordinators by 9 am on the day of the event.
5. The participants will be allotted a Participant Number as their identification for each of the competitions. Only that number should be indicated in the presented material. Any attempt to indicate the name of the student and / or the name of the parent institution in the essay / painting / working model shall lead to automatic disqualification of the participating individual / team
6. Decision of the Judges will be final and binding on all the participants.
7. Results shall be announced in the valedictory function to be held on 9th February 2019.

Rules specific for essay contest

Topic: **"INNOVATIVE METHODS IN LEARNING PHYSIOLOGY"**

1. Essays must be restricted to 1000 – 1500 words and written on the spot.
2. Time to complete the essay shall be 1 hour.
3. Papers and pens will be provided by the organizers.
4. Criteria for judging the essays
 - a. Originality of the content;
 - b. Organisation of ideas
 - c. Presentation
 - d. Abiding by the word limit and time limit as prescribed.

Rules specific for painting contest

1. Prescribed time to complete the painting is 2 hrs 30 mins.
2. Participants must paint only from the topics provided.
3. Charts will be provided.
4. Participants must bring their own painting materials.
5. Paintings will be judged based on
 - a. Interpretation and clarity of the topic explained
 - b. Creativity
 - c. Neatness and management of space in the provided material
 - d. Colour combination.

Rules specific for contest in creating working models

Note: Individual members of a team must register separately

1. Participation can be by individuals (or) as 2 - 6 member teams
2. All the participants should report to the Co-ordinator by 9:00 am on the day of event
3. Topic selection to be done only once by the team leader. Other team members must only indicate participation in this event.
4. Basic blocks of the models can be brought but assembling the complete working model must be done on the spot only.
5. Any type of material can be used (No restriction on materials to be used).
6. The time provided for completion shall be three hours.
7. The models shall be judged based on the following criteria
 - a. Creativity
 - b. Demonstration of the concept
 - c. Robustness of the design
 - d. Thoroughness, skill and clarity.

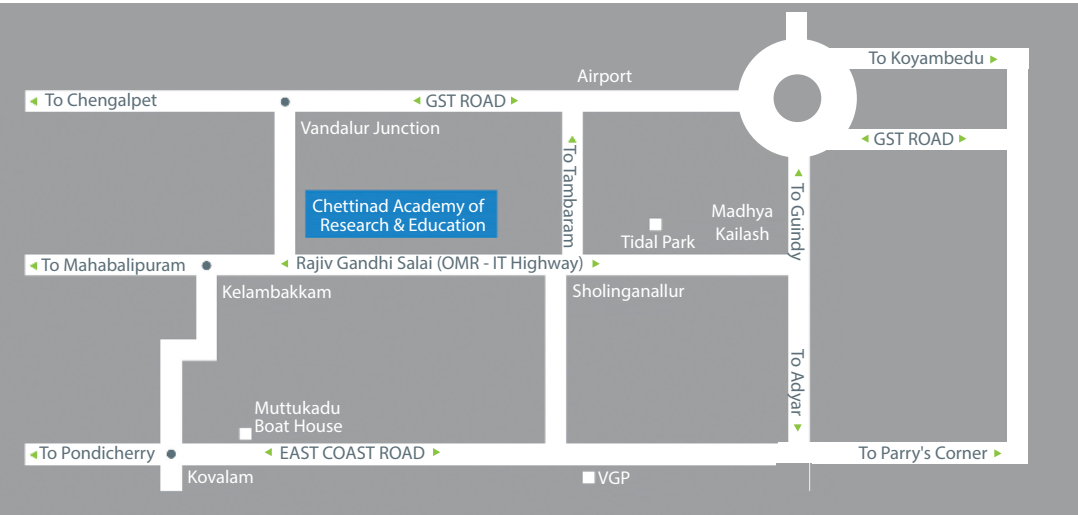
