A fresh batch of students were inducted into the Chettinad School of Law on Monday, 31st August 2020. The Orientation Programme was preceded by Individual Counselling sessions. The students were given a warm welcome by the faculty of the School of Law – a brief idea of the School was first presented, the students were then enlightened on the symbiotic relationship between themselves and the Institution – what could be expected from the Chettinad School of Law and what was expected of the students in return. An ice-breaking session was conducted wherein the students enthusiastically introduced themselves – everyone expressed their personal interests as well as their academic background and professional ambitions.

The students who are pursuing their 2nd year of the law course extended a hearty welcome to the freshers. This was followed by a fun legal quiz that was conducted for the new members of the Chettinad School of Law family by the existing students and it saw the eager and spirited participation of the students. Students of both the batches cordially interacted with each other under the presence of the faculty of the School of Law.

The new entrants were then taken on a virtual tour of the campus and a special video was made by a student of the Chettinad School of Law for this occasion which highlighted the activities and events that School of Law participated in and conducted the previous year. During this session, special focus was placed on the Winter School conducted at Gujarat National Law University, participation of students in various National Moot Court Competitions and an International Arbitration Competition, exposure and knowledge received by attending National and International Seminars, Workshops and Conferences. The students were further told about the interactive and insightful sessions conducted by expat faculty on International Jurisprudence and Comparative Constitutional Law, the role of the Placement & Internship Cell of the School of Law and the diverse internship experiences and opportunities of the students. The freshers were also encouraged to participate in the various committees running under the aegis of the School of Law.

The orientation programme ended with a synergetic session that saw the animated participation of the students in which the undergraduates of both the batches interacted with each other, the existing students answering the questions the new entrants had. This session was conducted with an aim to acclimatise the new students on the existing culture prevalent in Chettinad School of Law and to help them find their footing in a new environment.
