

CHRI PROGRAM OUTCOME FOR MBBS

1. To demonstrate knowledge of normal and abnormal human structure, function and development from a molecular, cellular, biologic, clinical, behavioral and social perspective
2. To demonstrate knowledge of National, Regional health policies, health care delivery systems, medico-legal, societal, ethical and humanitarian principles that influence health care and the basic principles of disease prevention and health promotion
3. To demonstrate the ability to elicit and record from the patient and other relevant sources, the history and the ability to perform complete physical examination that are complete and relevant to disease identification, prevention, management and health promotion
4. To maintain accurate, clear and appropriate records of the patient in conformation with legal & administrative frameworks besides safely administering appropriate therapies in alignment with regional health programs and policies.
5. To demonstrate ability to appropriately identify and refer patients to higher centers and to provide a continuum of care with basic clinical and translational research.
6. To work effectively and appropriately with colleagues and subordinates as a health care team leader in any health care settings besides educating & motivating the team to maximize the health care delivery, utilizing the appropriate health care system in compliance with the national health care policies

7. To participate appropriately and effectively in research that will advance the quality of health care and patient safety
8. To recognize and advocate health promotion, disease prevention and health care quality improvement through early recognition and prevention of lifestyle diseases, cancer and infectious diseases in collaboration with other members of health care team
