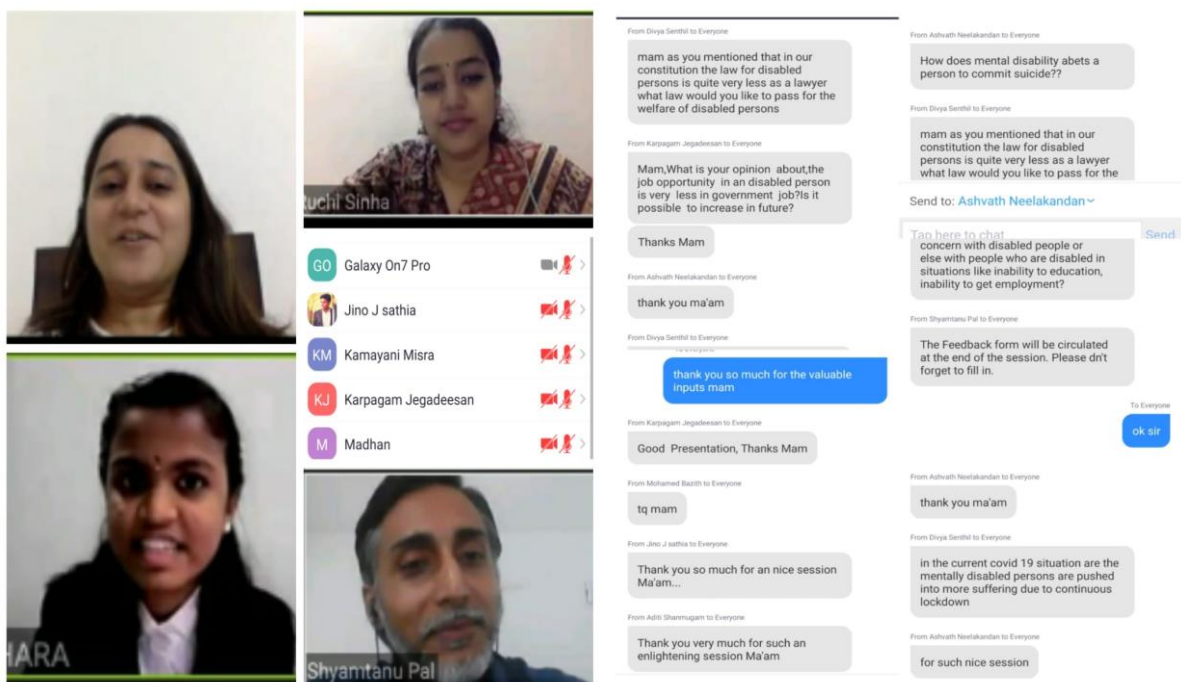


CHETTINAD SCHOOL OF LAW – GUEST LECTURE SERIES 2020

“NAVIGATING THROUGH THE CONTOURS OF DISABILITY LAW IN INDIA”

The Chettinad School of Law hosted a Guest Lecture on 27th June 2020 on the topic **’Navigating through the contours of Disability Law in India’**. The esteemed speaker for the day was **Ms. Isha Khurana, Legal Specialist, Centre for Policy Research, New Delhi**. The moderator of the session was Ms. R. Tushara, student, Chettinad School of Law.

The speaker started off the session by defining the Disability Law and its models such as Medical Model, Social Model, Human Rights Model. The speaker then gave an overview in the magnitude of disability, constitutional framework, accessibility, etc.

The speaker then highlighted as to how the directive principles of state policy plays a role in constitutional framework. Ms Isha also discussed the present scenario of disability law and how it will be followed in future. She also shared her knowledge on the Evolution & Formulation of Disability Law in India along with the impediments taking place in Disability Law in India such as Social Impediments, Structural Impediments and Cultural Impediments. So, overall within a short span of time she covered the outline of Disability Law in India.
