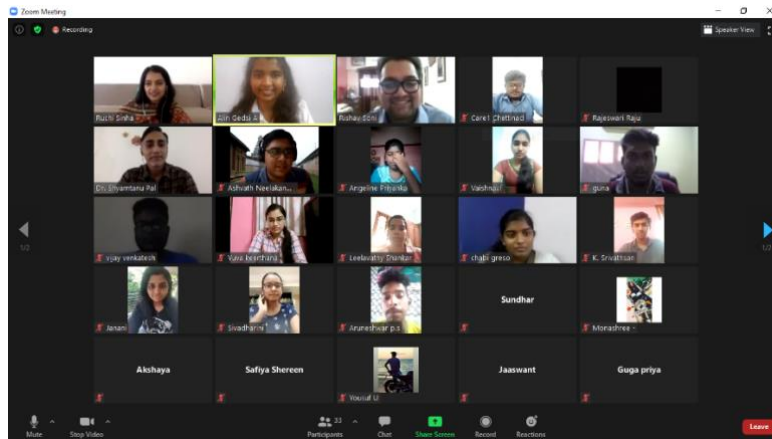


“LEGAL WRITING WORKSHOP”
