The National workshop on Pharmacovigilance was conducted on 27.11.2020 through online Zoom platform. 50 participants from various institutes across India attended the workshop.

The objective of the workshop was to impart knowledge on pharmacovigilance and train the participants on ADR reporting, Causality assessment and Signal detection.

The program was started with Inauguration. The Co chairperson of the workshop and Vice Principal, CHRI, Dr.R.Arunkumar, Professor of Pharmacology introduced the theme of the workshop. The organizing secretary, Dr.S.Saradha conducted the proceedings of the workshop.

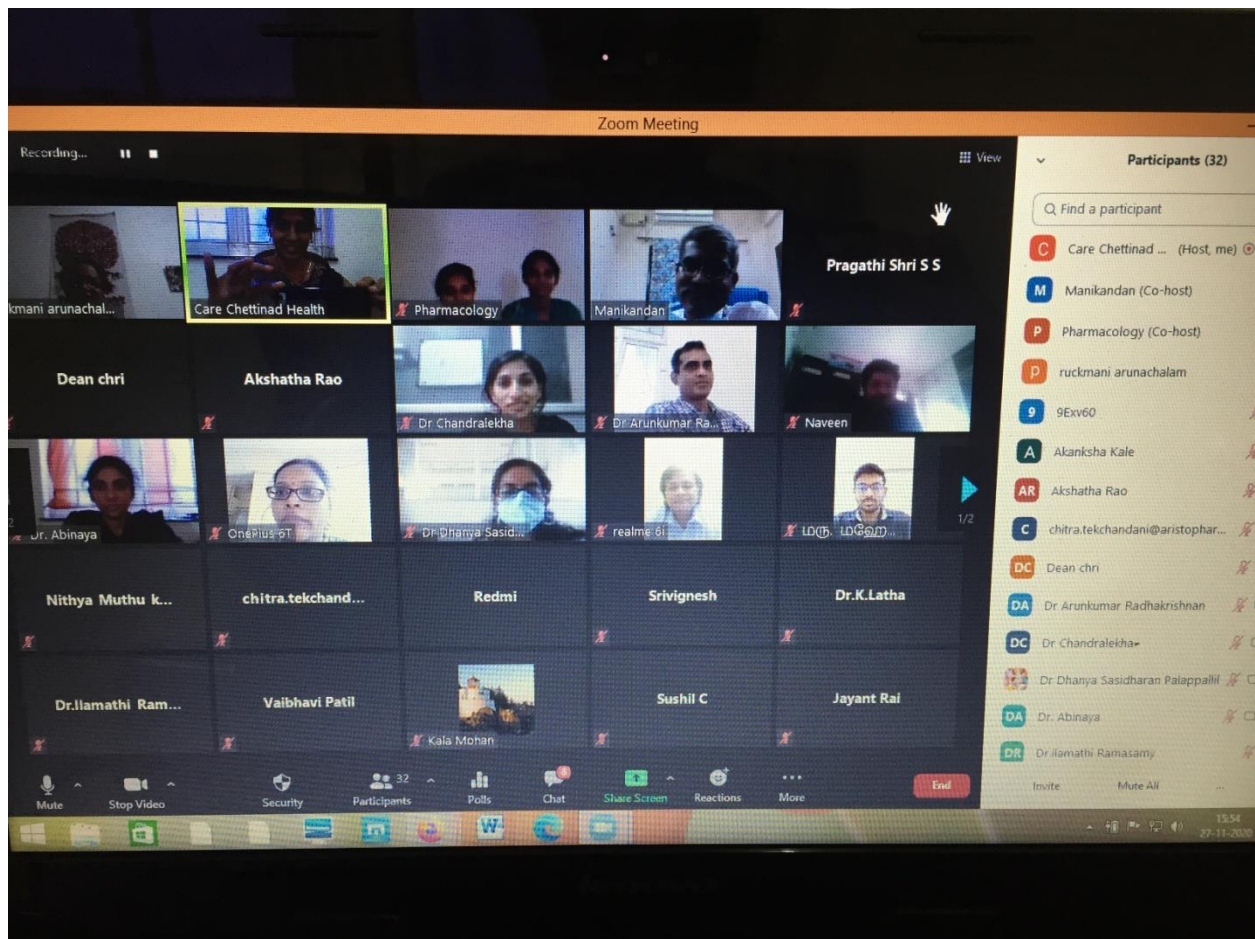
