DST SERB has raised a call for receiving application for research funding for catalyzing technology translation through core research programs under Start-up Research Grant, Core Research Grant, Teachers Associateship for Research Excellence. The call encourages faculty:

- a. To apply for start-up grant, and it is applicable for those who have moved to CARE within the last two years.
- b. To apply for core research grants for proposal with potential product for development.

Three areas (pertaining to CARE) for funding in life science are:

1. Biomedical and Health Sciences
2. Interdisciplinary Biological Sciences
3. Organismal and Evolutionary Biology
4. Chemical, Engineering and Physical Sciences

In this regard, Faculty of Allied Health Sciences (FAHS), CHRI and School of Pharmaceutical Sciences (CSPS) of CARE are jointly organizing a hands-on grant writing workshop.

Requirements for participation in Workshop

- a. The total number of participants would be limited to 50.
- b. Pre-registration is needed.

- c. No registration fees.
- d. A two to three page writeup of their proposal for funding.
- e. Presentation with maximum 15 slides including background, review of literature, gap in literature, scope, methodology, proposed budget, instrument requirement and expected outcome.

The workshop will help the potential Principal Investigator (PI) to reorient their concepts to meet the SERB Call. The workshop will have a one hour lecture followed by discussion on the proposal presented by the individual Principal Investigator providing input to make it winnable.
