


1. Online /Social Media promotion of Gandhi ji teachings, quotes etc

Under guidance of Mrs. Nancy Victoria.J, 50 NSS Volunteers from nursing actively participated in tree plantation in their respective places with all safety measures.




3. Quiz on Mahatma Gandhi


