The Dean presided over the meeting. At the outset he welcomed all the members and inform them about the Anti Ragging measures being taken up by our institution to monitor a strict vigilance to curb such menace. He also highlighted the following measures taken by our Institution

1. During the First year Admission, an orientation program is arranged where the First M.B.B.S. students will participate along with their senior students. The Dean, Faculty of Various Departments, the Wardens and Administrators will also address the students and stresse the importance of maintaining the Campus "Ragging Free"
2. An Annual undertaking is obtained from each student and her / his parents that they are aware of relevant instructions against ragging and the punishments, if found guilty. The undertaking is obtained in English and vernacular language.
3. The Confidentiality of the students will be maintained, who may report, in the eventuality of any incident of Ragging. The students are being encouraged to lodge their report either orally or in writing or through some third party, so as to take prompt action.
4. A documentary on Anti ragging which was placed on UGC Website has been linked to our Learning Management System (LMS) and over LMS we are also making it more prominent in the website.


5. We have erected hoardings and disseminated the information to curb the menace of Ragging through Notice Boards and Banners in prominent places within the campus. Information to the students is displayed explaining what is Ragging and the punishment that shall be awarded, if any of them committed / participated / abetted or propagate Ragging.
6. In the Hand book issued to the fresher's every year at the time of admission, it has been clearly emphasized that Ragging is a criminal offence in any form and therefore students are strictly warned to refrain from any such kind of Ragging activities.
7. The extract of the provisions contained under "Tamil Nadu prohibition of Ragging Act" are appraised to the students before their admissions to the First Year course.
8. All efforts are taken to ensure round the clock monitoring of the campus against Ragging by posting faculty members on duty at the campus by turns.
9. The Chettinad Academy of Research and Education and its constituent Colleges viz Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute and Chettinad College of Nursing are strictly implementing the Guidelines of the Government of Tamil Nadu, UGC and MCC to curb the menace of Ragging.

In conclusion the members were requested to ensure the prevention of Ragging in and around the campus. In the event, if any, incidence comes across in our campus the Member should take prompt action to bring it to the notice of the Dean, CHRI.
