The Dean has informed all the members to implement the guidelines as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and UGC.

Minutes:

1. The students should be well informed of the fact that ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in our campus and they should refrain from any ragging activities.
2. Frequent awareness meetings to be organized with students to advise them to regulate their own movements and interactions, especially with strangers.

3. Members were requested to ensure the prevention of ragging in and around the campus. If any untoward event incidents happen, the members should bring the fact to the notice of the convenor immediately.
4. With the start of new academic year, orientation sessions to be conducted for all the students newly admitted as well as the senior students in different streams under the institution. The Dean, faculty of various departments, the warden and the administrators may address the students and stress the importance of maintaining the campus Ragging free.
5. The students should be emphasized in the orientation classes that those who involves in ragging in any form will be suspended immediately from the college and Hostel and they are liable for punishments as decided by the Anti Ragging Committee.
