

Minutes:

1. Before the start of new academic year, it was planned to conduct orientation sessions to the newly admitted students as well as the senior students in different streams under the institution. 2. The students should be emphasized in the orientation classes that those who involves in ragging in any form will be suspended immediately from the college and Hostel and they are liable for punishments as decided by the Anti Ragging Committee.
3. Efforts to emphasize that ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in our campus and they should refrain from any ragging activities.
4. Frequent awareness meetings to be organized with students to advise them to regulate their own movements and interactions, especially with strangers.
5. Members were requested to ensure the prevention of ragging in and around the campus. If any untoward event incidents happen, the members should bring the fact to the notice of the convener immediately.
