IV Admission Procedure

Eligibility for admission to M.B.B.S. degree course:

- a) The candidates should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or should complete that age on or before 31st December 2023. The candidates must be born on or before 31.12.2006.
- b) Candidates should have qualified in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test NEET-UG 2023 by scoring the minimum eligible score conducted by the National Testing Agency, New Delhi.

- c) Candidates should have obtained the minimum percentage of marks in the qualifying examination as per the norms of the National Medical Commission, New Delhi.

i) Candidates must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% of marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology / Biotechnology in the qualifying examinations.

ii) In respect of candidates belonging to scheduled caste, scheduled tribes or other backward classes, the minimum marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology / Biotechnology taken together in qualifying examination shall be 40%.

iii) In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 the minimum marks in qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology or (Botany and Zoology) / Biotechnology taken together shall be 45%.

- d) All admissions to MBBS degree course within the respective categories shall be based solely on the marks obtained in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET)-UG 2023.

For all other eligibility conditions, the website of the National Medical Commission, New Delhi may be referred.

The candidates who do not qualify the NEET-UG-2023 Examination conducted by NTA are not eligible for admission to MBBS degree course.

Counseling:

As per the Notification, there shall be a common Counseling for all seats of Deemed to be University in various rounds at National level to be conducted by the Medical Counseling Committee of DGHS, New Delhi.

There are four rounds of counseling for deemed universities i.e., Round 1, Round 2, Mopup Round and Stray Vacancy Round. All rounds will be conducted through online by the Medical Counseling Committee as per the schedule of Counseling by the MCC.

Candidates who intend to apply for admission to M.B.B.S. degree course for the academic year 2023-24, in Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute are advised to register themselves through online web portal of Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi i.e. **www.mcc.nic.in** (Medical Counseling Committee) for participating in common counseling and they are advised to periodically check the MCC website for updates viz., **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ), Schedule/re-schedule** of counseling dates and its process etc.

On obtaining the online provisional allotment order from the MCC of Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi, the allotted candidate shall report to the **University office, Chettinad Academy of Research and Education** and fill the application cum reporting form along with the allotment order within the due date as indicated in the allotment order and pay the entire tuition fee and other applicable fee etc., for the academic year 2023-24. Otherwise the candidate shall forfeit his/her offer of admission to the course in the Institution without any notice and will have no right to claim the seat, in future.

Candidates provisionally allotted for admission will have to submit all required original certificates with the Institution. Therefore, candidates are advised to keep with them sufficient number of photocopies of their certificates.

VII Rules for Refund:

The amount of fee to be deducted in case candidate resigns after counseling period / cutoff date:

Where any student applies for discontinuance, migration or without any application discontinues on his/her own, from the course to which he/she has been admitted to, for any reason, either on or after the cut-off date prescribed by the statutory and/or University authorities for admission to the first year of the course or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate such students will have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the 'entire/remaining course period'.

VIII General Information:

The selection and admission to MBBS seats in this University is subject to fulfilling the eligibility, medical fitness and such criteria as may be prescribed by the Medical Counseling Committee, New Delhi, Medical Council of India / National Medical Commission and this University. If it is found at a later stage, that the candidates have submitted false information / forged certificates, his/her admission will be cancelled without any notice, fee paid will be forfeited and liable for legal action and the same shall be final and binding.

Candidates with provisional allotment letter are advised to submit all the necessary original documents, pay the tuition and join as early as possible and not to wait for last day of joining, considering the time required for verification of original documents and to complete admission formalities.

If a candidate fails to report on the date and time specified by MCC of DGHS in the provisional allotment order along with the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee by Demand Draft/Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS with UTR No.

Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/ College/University and come for admission with a certificate stating that "their original certificates are deposited with the Institute / College / University" will not be allowed to take admission as directed by DGHS, New Delhi.

Admitted students are bound by the Rules and Regulations of this University framed from time to time in the matter of syllabus, examinations, fee structure, discipline and policy for refund of fee etc.

The University reserves the right to change any of the conditions enumerated periodically or for the purpose of complying with any of the regulations of the statutory councils.

Tuition fee and other dues payable in the subsequent academic years shall be paid by the students within the due date fixed by the Institution failing which the name of the defaulting students shall be removed from the rolls of the college after the expiry of due date.

Candidates himself / herself must be present at the time of counseling / reporting. No proxy will be allowed in any circumstances.

All disputes arising in the interpretation and implementation of the provisions in this information bulletin will be referred to the Vice Chancellor, Chettinad Academy of Research and Education and the decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final and binding.

In respect of matters relating to or arising out of this information bulletin, the jurisdiction shall be at Chennai alone.

It is a general advisory to all students admitted in MBBS course at Chettinad Hospital and Research institute that they do not avail any long period of leave during the course of study and try to complete the course within the stipulated period as prescribed by NMC/MCI. A learner shall not be entitled to graduate later than ten (10) years of her / his joining the first MBBS course.

Without original documents and payment of tuition fee candidate will be considered as "Not reported".

Date of Birth and Name Registered as per School Records:

The candidate's name and date of birth will be registered in the university's records exactly as stated in the HSC/Transfer certificates. It is important to note that any requests for changes or corrections to the name and date of birth shall not be entertained at any point of time, during the course of study including midway or after completion or exit from the course.

Hence both the parents and candidates carefully review and confirm these entries in the HSC mark statement/Transfer certificates during the admission time. It is crucial to ensure the accuracy of this information without fail.

IX Ragging in any form is prohibited in the University Campus:

The University follows a Zero Tolerance Policy towards Ragging. Ragging in any form is a crime and a punishable offence. As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, University Grants Commission has framed "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009" and the National Medical Commission / Medical Council of India has framed "(Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges/Institutions) Regulations, 2009" and notified in the Govt. of India Gazette in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory and provides for punishment of those who abet and indulge in ragging, directly or indirectly.
