- It was discussed in the meeting to circulate the login credentials of subscribed e-resources to all students and faculty members of the University. Access will be provided within the campus through Wi-Fi and outside the campus through remote access. The respective schools and colleges of CARE University will share the oredentials through the registered email IDs of their students and faculty members.
- It was discussed in the meeting to request the hostel wardens to permit hostelfers to utilize the library after normal working hours and on holidays, in order to encourage extended academic use of library resources.
