I. ABOUT NEET-PG 2025 ENTRANCE EXAMINATION CONDUCTED BY THE NATIONAL BOARD OF EXAMINATIONS IN MEDICAL SCIENCES (NBE MS) ON AUGUST 3rd OF 2025.

NEET-PG 2025 is an eligibility-cum-ranking examination prescribed as the single window entrance examination for admission to various MD/MS Courses Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2023. Qualifying NEET-PG is mandatory for entry to MD/MS courses under various Universities/ Institutions in the country.

Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute is a constituent Medical College of Chettinad Academy of Research and Education (Deemed to be University u/s 3 of the UGC Act 1956) conducts PG Medical Courses (MD and MS) in various clinical and Non clinical Specialties. The Selection for PG Admissions is based on the rank obtained in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET PG-2025).

1. Admission to Postgraduate Medical Courses: All Admissions are strictly based on the merit at NEET PG 2025 and the Counselling conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) duly constituted by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi. Please refer to the MCC website for details at: <https://mcc.nic.in> www.mcc.nic.in
2. Register on www.mcc.nic.in under Deemed University category and you are eligible for Choice filling.
3. Please note that 100% of all seats in postgraduate courses are available on deemed /paid seats with 15% of seats reserved for NRI / OCI students. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the MCC website for latest notifications regarding counselling schedule and other updates after NEET-PG 2025 results. Candidates must also visit care.edu.in frequently for further instructions and guidelines regarding reporting for admissions.
4. Admission Process: Once you have been allocated a seat for a PG Course at Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute Kelambakkam Tamil Nadu, through the Centralized Counselling process by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of DGHS New Delhi, please report to the Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute to complete the admission process on or before the stipulated date and time mentioned in the seat 'Allotment Letter' generated/downloaded online from the MCC web portal.

V Admission Procedure

Eligibility for admission to M.D. / M.S. degree courses:

Candidates aspiring to join postgraduate programs must have successfully cleared the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET PG-2025) conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences, New Delhi, on 03.08.2025, with results declared on 19.08.2025. Eligibility is contingent upon meeting the minimum percentile requirements as established by the National Medical Commission, New Delhi

Additionally, candidates must have completed a one-year MBBS internship by 31.07.2025. Indian citizens with foreign medical qualifications must have passed NEET-PG 2025 and the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) and be registered with the NMC or a State Medical Council. NEET-PG is mandatory even for foreign nationals seeking admission in medical courses in India.

Counseling Process:

In accordance with the PG Medical Education Regulations 2023, under clause 4.3 of common counselling, a centralized counseling process will be conducted for all PG courses based on the NEET-PG merit list by the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) of the Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi. All rounds of counseling for all seats will be held online.

Prospective students should register online at the MCC's official website (www.mcc.nic.in) and stay updated with the counseling schedule and related information. Upon receiving an online letter of allotment to CHRI, candidates must report to the University office to complete the application and reporting formalities, including payment of tuition and other fees for the academic year 2025-26, by the specified dates.

Failure to comply with these requirements will result in forfeiture of the admission offer. Candidates must also present all original certificates at the time of admission and are advised to retain sufficient photocopies for their records.

The amount of fee to be deducted in case the candidate resigns after counseling period / cutoff date:

Where any student applies for discontinuance, or without any application discontinues on his/her own, from the course to which he/she has been admitted to, for any reason, either on or after the cut-off date prescribed by the statutory and/or University authorities for admission to the first year of the course or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate such students will have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the 'entire/ remaining course period'.

IX General Information:

Admissions to Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute are subject to meeting all eligibility criteria set forth by the University and statutory bodies such as the National Medical Commission/Medical Council of India. Any submission of false information or forged documents will result in immediate cancellation of admission, which is irrevocable.

Eligibility and Admission Process:

- Appearance in NEET-PG 2025 does not confer any automatic rights to secure a MD/MS seat.
- Selection is based on meeting eligibility criteria, medical fitness, and other conditions as prescribed by the MCC of DGHS, National Medical Commission, and the University.
- Candidates with provisional allotment obtained from MCC of DGHS must submit all required original documents and pay tuition fees promptly to avoid delays in the admission process.

- Candidates should ensure that their MBBS degree is recognized as per provisions of the NMC Act, 2019 and the Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2023. If it is found at any time that MBBS degree is not recognized, the candidature / result of the candidate shall be cancelled/ deemed to be cancelled.

Reporting and Documentation:

- Candidates must report in person at the specified date and time with all original certificates/documents.
- Failure to report or pay fees will result in the inability to proceed on the day of admission.
- Candidates without original certificates / Documents shall not be allowed to get admission.

University Regulations:

- Admitted students are subject to the University's rules regarding syllabus, examinations, fees, discipline, and fee refund policies.
- The University reserves the right to amend regulations in accordance with statutory council guidelines.
- Tuition and other fees for subsequent academic years must be paid by the due date, or enrollment may be terminated.

Attendance and Leave Policy:

- Students are advised against taking extended leaves during the course of study and should aim to complete their courses within three years.
- Leave due to illness or maternity will extend the study period by the same number of days for which maternity/paternal leave and total excess casual leave taken have been availed in 3 years.
- Re-admission after a study break requires a condonation order from the University and payment of prescribed fees.

Training Requirements:

- Students must serve as full-time residents and attend at least 80% of training to be eligible for examinations.
- Rigorous training and class attendance are essential for acquiring comprehensive medical knowledge.

Postgraduate Academic and Training Requirements:

To qualify for final examinations, postgraduate students must fulfill one of the following:

- Present a poster or deliver a podium presentation at a recognized conference in their specialty.
- Publish or have accepted for publication a research paper as the first author in a specialty journal.

Mandatory Courses:

- Research Methodology: Complete an online course in the first year, with certification required for final exam eligibility.
- Ethics: Complete a course in ethics, including Good Clinical Practices and Good Laboratory Practices, in the first year, with certification necessary for exam participation.
- Cardiac Life Support Skills: Complete Basic and Advanced Cardiac Life Support courses in the first year, with certification mandatory for exam eligibility.

These requirements are applicable to all postgraduate students and are integral to the eligibility criteria for final examinations.

District Residency Programme:

To integrate Postgraduate students into the healthcare services, participation in the District Residency Programme is mandatory for a period of 3 months, providing essential exposure to the District Health System and District Hospitals.

No Migration: No student admitted in PG courses shall be permitted migration to any other Medical institutions as per NMC Norms.

Postgraduate students must retain the date of birth as recorded on their 12th-grade mark sheet. Any requests for Date of birth changes will not be entertained by the university.

Legal and Disciplinary Matters:

- All disputes related to this Prospectus/ information bulletin will be decided by the Vice Chancellor, whose decision is final.
- Legal jurisdiction for matters arising from this bulletin lies exclusively in Chennai.

Tamil Nadu Medical Council Directives:

- Other state Candidates pursuing postgraduate, should compulsorily register in Tamil Nadu Medical Council "within three months of admission"
- In case of failure to register within the prescribed time (3 Months) Rs.10,000/- would be levied as fine, in addition to the normal registration fees.

Ragging in any form is prohibited in the University Campus:

- The University enforces a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging, which is a criminal offense.
- Strict adherence to UGC and NMC/MCI anti-ragging regulations is mandatory, with penalties for violators.
